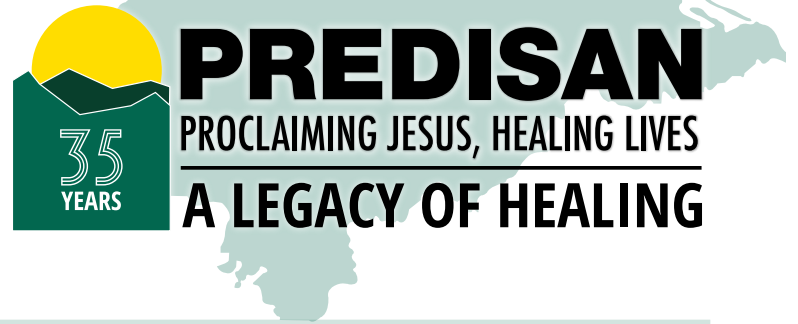


2021 MID-YEAR IMPACT REPORT

Healthcare

- 81,815 total patients treated
- 256,519 patient encounters
- 4,266 COVID-19 vaccinations (in Catacamas and Culmí)
- 95 general surgeries performed by local surgeons



Community Development

- Healthy Schools Project: 76 students from five rural schools served with physical exams, vitamin supplements, dental kits and fluoridation and daily school snacks



Spiritual Development

- 4,925 devotional meetings
- 2,117 pastoral visits
- 1,756 counseling sessions
- 2,970 personal prayer meetings
- 625 discipleship study sessions with staff and patients



Rehabilitation

- 3,985 patient therapy sessions
- 361 family therapy sessions
- 96 patients completed program
- 105 total patients treated



Education

- 247 students have received financial aid, academic tutoring, pastoral and medical care

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
