DEDICATION OF HCC BUILDINGS



The Nimoh Media Centre will house the Truth TV (which currently reaches 5 million homes and 23 countries in West and Central Africa) and in the not too distant future, will also house the HCC Radio and a printing press.



The Farmington House is a 17-bedroom faculty guest house which also provides space for small group studies and prayer meetings.



The Boateng Building is a multi-purpose building which provides lecture rooms, offices, a conference room, a state-of-the-art computer lab as well as an auditorium and a cafeteria. The first floor would house HCC's Nursing department while the second floor would house the School of Graduate Studies and Research – both of which will be rolled out soon.

Other ongoing building construction projects would be unveiled and dedicated upon completion.
